

DR ANNE MARTINDALE (nee Jacques)

Dr Anne Martindale, retired Consultant Anaesthetist. Qualified University of Liverpool 1958. Died 25th June 2022.

Dr Anne Martindale (nee Jacques) died peacefully at Fazakerley Hospital on 25th June 2022.

She had suffered with debilitating Parkinson's Disease for several years.

Anne qualified as a doctor from Liverpool University in 1958 and trained as an Anaesthetist in the region. She married John Martindale in 1961 and they had 4 children, the eldest of which (Liz) was a Consultant Obstetrician.

Anne worked around her family doing different anaesthetic sessions including St Catherine's Hospital Birkenhead, Broad Green Hospital and anaesthetised for the ECT sessions at Rainhill Hospital and then Whiston for many years. She was an accomplished dental anaesthetist and did dental sessions until they were incorporated into hospital practice. She also undertook paediatric sessions at Waterloo Hospital and Olive Mount.

On retirement she spent several rewarding years as a Mental Health Manager making sure the Mental Health Act was followed for those patients who had been detained.

She combined her consultant career with raising four children, but still had time to help on the PTA and mentor junior colleagues.

Her husband John, a Haematologist at Walton and Fazakerley Hospitals sadly died in 2005. She lived independently for many years, but then moved to a nursing home in Crosby.

She will be sadly missed by her four children, Liz, Nick, Joanna and Louisa and her 9 grandchildren.
