Abstract Guidance

New for 2019, this year's preparation course will include a poster competition for delegates. There are two categories available for submission:

- 'My Radiology Journey'
- Radiology-based audit

Prizes for first, second and third place will be awarded in each category.

My Radiology Journey

This category will allow delegates to showcase the achievements they have already made with relation to their career ambitions to become a clinical radiologist. Posters in this category should detail projects, audits, placements and tasters that delegates have undertaken. The idea of this poster is to inform others of what you have found interesting and useful in your preparations so far, with a view to inspiring others to start a radiology journey of their own. No more than 250 words of free text should be used for the submission of this abstract.

Radiology-based audit

This category is based on a more traditional poster style, showcasing audit work that delegates have undertaken during their undergraduate or professional years to date. Abstracts should have a clinical radiology 'flavour' and relate to an audit or quality improvement project. Delegates should use the following headings in the creation of their abstract:

- Title and authors
- Background (to include audit standards and methodology)
- Results
- Conclusion/action plan
- References (if applicable)

Abstracts in both categories should be **no longer than 250 words.**

Please email your completed abstract to htgircourse@gmail.com with the subject line 'Abstract Submission'. Please clearly state in which of the categories you wish for your abstract to be considered. Delegates may submit one abstract in each category if they wish.

Please ensure you have a registered place on the course before submitting an abstract.

The poster-judging panel will be announced in due course.

The deadline for all abstract submissions is **5pm on 28/10/2019 – deadline extended.**
